

# Toilet Handle Kit (E Type) Installation Instructions


## **Parts Supplied**

(one of each of the following)

- A. Screw
- B. Lever Arm
- C. Locking Nut
- **D.** Thread
- E. Lever

#### Tools Required (not supplied)

1 x cross head screwdriver



### **Assembly**

- 1. Check and familiarise yourself with all the components.
- **2.** Take lever **(E)**, and insert thread **(D)** through the toilet handle hole opening in the cistern wall.
- 3. Once in place take locking nut (C) and tighten onto thread (D), please do not over tighten.
- **4.** Now the lever is in place, hook lever arm **(B)** onto the Syphon 'C' Link .
- **5.** Once this is attached lift lever arm **(B)** to meet chrome spindle on lever **(E)** and slide the lever arm over the spindle into position.
- **6.** Secure in place using screw **(A)**.
- Check handle is functioning correctly and is free from obstructions.
- **8.** Adjustments can be made to the lever arm if required (Use a hacksaw and cut carefully in front of desired hole selection).
